

No rest for the redevelopment

The twelve week move plan into the new 12-storey building is now complete, with 67 moves taking place over the course of 84 days! Lead by a team of project experts, the mammoth task was made possible with the help of hundreds of staff who supported the big change at Campbelltown Hospital. It has been a sensational effort and marks a huge milestone in the hospital's 45 years of service.

Now abuzz with activity, the Emergency Department, Maternity, Birthing, Mental Health units and more, have successfully transitioned into their new spaces. A major investment in healthcare for the Macarthur region, the new building showcases the commitment to delivering outstanding patient care to the local community in world-class facilities.

There's no rest for the redevelopment project, with the next round of refurbishment works commencing in the now vacant spaces within the existing buildings. Until late 2023, the former Emergency Department area, Renal Dialysis Unit, Clinical Sterilisation Services Department, and some areas of the Macarthur Cancer Therapy Centre will receive a range of enhancements and expansions.

In addition to the above plans, works are set to commence on the decommissioning of the old Waratah House and Gna Ka Lun buildings, and current Building C. With the recent integration of the Mental Health units into the new building, the retired buildings will be removed in readiness for landscaping and an additional entrance.

Set to continue until late 2023, the \$632 million Stage 2 redevelopment will bring brand new equipment and innovative solutions to the Campbelltown Hospital campus. Innovation is at the heart of healthcare

Integration and innovation is at the heart of the \$632 million Stage 2 redevelopment at Campbelltown Hospital. The new state-of-the-art clinical services building enhances access to care through new ways of working and additional equipment that will transform healthcare in the Macarthur region.

At the frontline of innovation is the new hybrid operating theatre at Campbelltown Hospital. Seamlessly integrating angiography, CT and ultrasound in a single suite, the two-room space will harness the power of imaging to guide operations.

Images and scans made during an operation will be displayed on large screens in the theatre, helping inform medical care and diagnoses. This major advancement in our theatres and medical imaging space provides clinicians opportunity to develop and perform innovative and minimally invasive procedures, reducing patient recovery time.

The expanded space connects to the previous theatres via a dedicated link bridge and is in close proximity to high-speed lifts that go directly to the new rooftop helipad and other key clinical areas. The increased operating theatre capacity will meet future demand and enable implementation of new models of care and surgical clinical pathways.
