## ONE WEEK TO GO

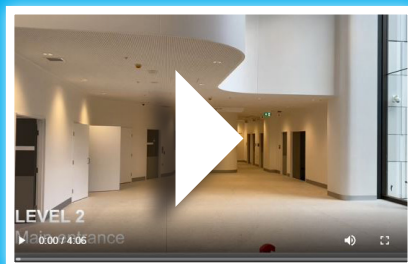
With only one week until we commence our 12-week move plan, our team is working hard to ensure your new building is ready and waiting for your arrival.

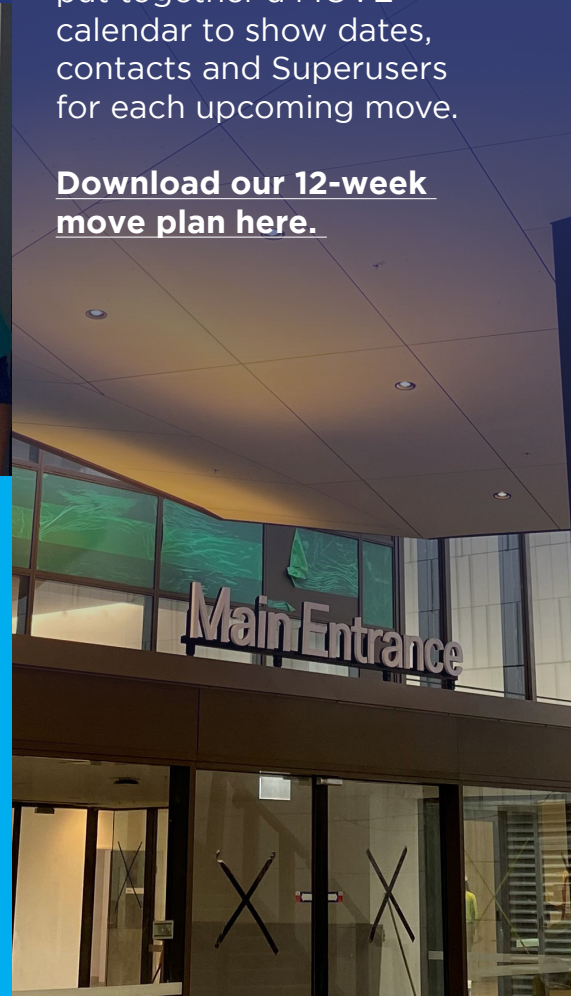
